

1. Otoscopy.
2. Anterior and posterior rhinoscopy.
3. Pharyngoscopy (epi-, meso-, hypopharyngoscopy).
4. Study of auditory function (whispering speech and tuning forks).
5. Interpretation of audiograms.
6. Study of nasal breathing and olfactory function.
7. Study of spontaneous nystagmus.
8. Study of spontaneous vestibular symptoms.
9. Pressor test.
10. Palpation of the paranasal sinuses.
11. Palpation of the mastoid processes.
12. Evaluation of the results of the rhinocytogram.
13. Taking biological material from the nose, oropharynx, ear.
14. Stopping nosebleeds (anterior nasal tamponade).
15. Washing the external auditory canal.
16. Instillation of drops in the nose and ear.
17. Interpretation of radiographs, magnetic resonance imaging and computed tomography of the nose and paranasal sinuses.
18. Caring for a tracheostomy.
19. Irrigation of the mucous membrane of the pharynx.
